

PINEDALE SHORES PROPERTY OWNERS BOATING AND FISHING RULES

Pinedale Shores Lake is for use by property owners only. The following rules and regulation apply to everyone.


- 1. To qualify for boat decals, you must be a property owner and be able to show proof of boat ownership. This proof of ownership is a copy of State of Alabama Boat Registration Certificate with correct name and address. All boats are to be registered at the office. Bill of sale for boats not required to be registered.
- 2. Decals must be placed in plain view on your boats. You will receive two decals, one for each side of the boat. You must have two decals to be legal.
- 3. You must have decals on all moving water vehicle, i.e. inboard, outboard and trolling motor, johnboats, jet skis, canoes, paddleboats, pontoon boats, etc.
- 4. NO GUEST BOATS, NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 5. Boat decals expire every year on June 1st. New decals must be on your boat no later than July 1st of each year.
- 6. It is permissible to try-out a boat, with interest in purchasing said boat, for one hour. You must have your membership card with you when trying out boat. No fishing, skiing or swimming while trying out boat. A pass from the office is required for your towing vehicle. A \$25.00 deposit is required for the pass. Pass
- 7. must be displayed on your vehicle and returned to office for a refund.
- 8. Reckless boating or intoxication while operating a boat will not be tolerated. Boat will be removed from lake by water patrol or St. Clair County Sheriffs Department IMMEDIATELY!
- 9. If you sell your boast you must remove Pinedale boat decals and turn into the office. Purchaser will have to apply for new stickers.
- 10. ABSOLUTELY NO FISHING ON THE SPILLWAY. (water flow area)

ALL ALBAMA STATE LAWS WILL BE ENFORCED ON THE LAKE

- 1. No alcohol allowed while operating boats.
- 2. People without flotation device can be fined.
- 3. Children under 12 in boats or on jet skis must wear life vests.
- 4. No boats within 25 feet of swimming area during swimming season.
- 5. No riders picked up at swimming raft.
- 6. No fishing within swimming cables at the beach.
- 7. After dusk (30 minutes before dark) all boat must have lights on.
- 8. No water skiing, kneeboarding, or tubing after dusk.

THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

ENJOY THE LAKE, BUT ABIDE BY THE RULES. THEY ARE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE LAKE AND PROPERTY OWNERS.



- (1). Keep to right side of lake.
- (2). Always make left turns.
- (3). Pull in all ski ropes before returning to dock.
- (4). Do not throw bottles or cans in the lake.
- (5). Bottles or cans are not allowed on dock.
- (6). Swimming not allowed beyond buoys at beach.
- (7). Do not follow too close to skier or another boat.
- (8). Show consideration to all fisherman, in or out of boats.
- (9). Do not go too close to docks or swimming areas.
- (10). Yield to traffic when leaving docks.
- (11). No cast fishing from beach pier.
- (12). Absolutely not trot Lines allowed in lake.

Boating is wonderful fun if properly controlled. It is your responsibility to keep it safe.
