Acceptance of Minutes: David made a motion to accept the 12/12/2022 Minutes. Michael Rabone seconded. Roll call vote was taken. Motion carried 5 yeas no nays

Old Business: None

New Business: Dana was given the floor. She stated she had called the police regarding kids on dirt bikes tearing up the dirt road in front of her house. The officer said Pinedale had an ordinance allowing them on the dirt roads so they could not take any action. After speaking with Francine she discovered there was no ordinance and she would like the board to pass one.

Discussion covered what the ordinance should cover, 4 wheelers, 3-wheel bikes and dirt bikes and residents would have to contact police file reports and press

charges for the ordinance to be effective and it should state roads and all common areas. Austin volunteered to take the matter to his attorney to create.

Motion was made by Austin and seconded by David. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion passed 5Yeas and no Nays.

The next matter was Budget shortfall. It was noted that Legal, Lake Maintenance, Road Maintenance, CD repayment and printing of new boat stickers must be put on hold.

Agenda was done and board members discussed exposed water pipes and it was agreed this is a matter to be taken to the county commissioner.

A discussion was opened on the matter of powers of the board. It was clarified that because the 2016 bylaws that opted into the HOA act were overturned, until bylaws pass where members agree to OPT into the Alabama HOA Act again certain legal protections and authorizations are not in place.

Final discussion was a need to hold some community meetings to try to get the members to understand the serious state of the Association and our community as a whole.
